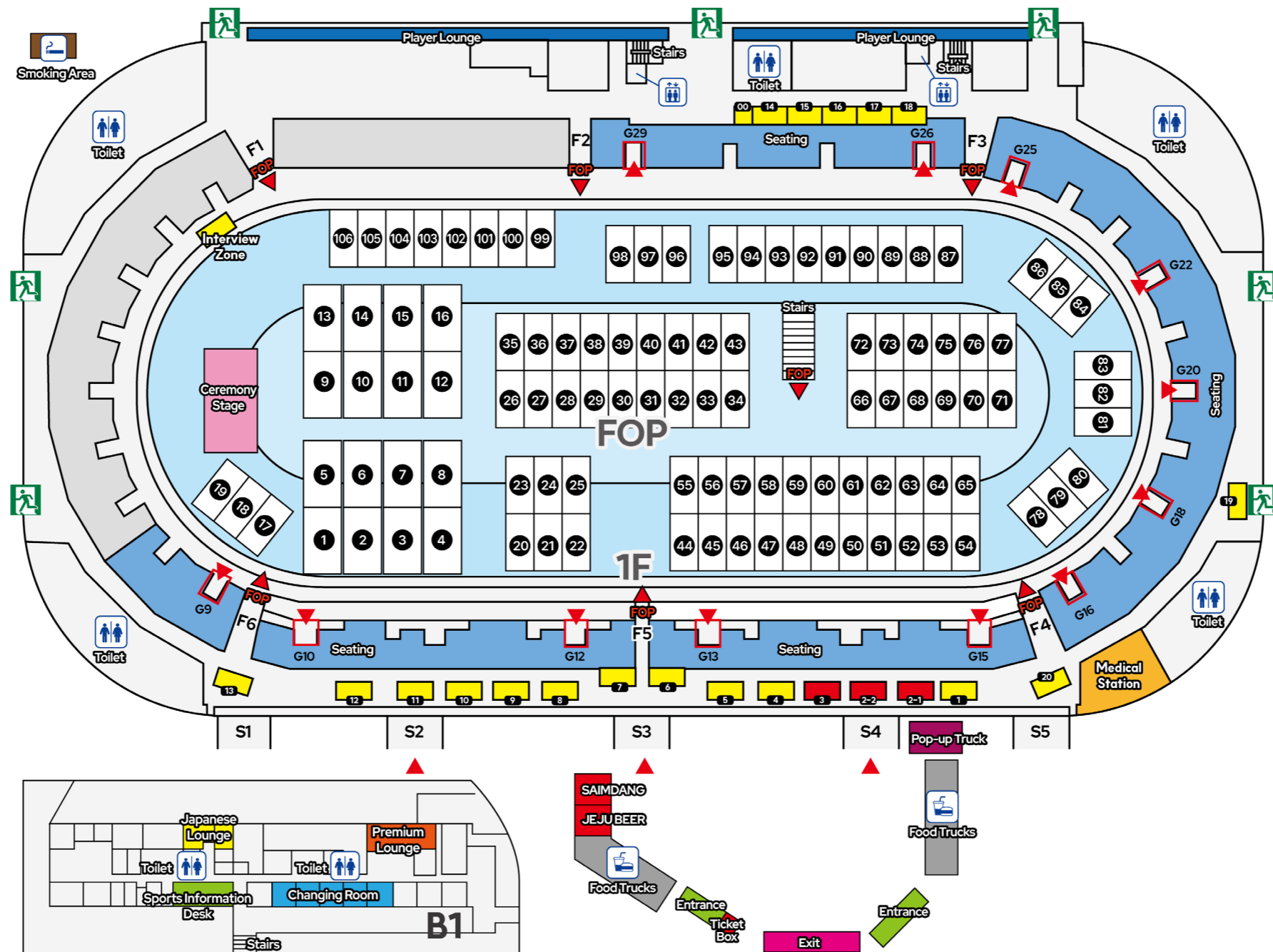

### STEP 01 Arrival at ICN / GMP Airport

Passengers arriving at the Incheon International Airport concourse should enter through the 2nd-floor boarding gate and take the shuttle train (operating 24/7) to the terminal.

### STEP 02 Information & Declaration

Passengers may complete the Arrival Card submission online from up to 3 days before arrival. Please be cautious of third-party agencies that encourage the use of paid submission services.

### Symbolic Design Reflecting the Nature and Dynamism of Gangneung

The emblem is designed to seamlessly bring together the three core elements of table tennis, Gangneung, and nature.

### Jangja and Gaksi, Embodying Tradition and Passion

The mascots draw inspiration from 'Jangjamari,' a beloved character from the traditional Gangneung Danoje Festival and have been reimagined for the global stage.

"Jangja" is characterized by eyes that sparkle with her heart-shaped pupils, a cheerful expression, and a prominent mustache, expressing a playful and unique personality.

"Gaksi" symbolizes excitement and passion for table tennis with her heart-shaped pupils and bright smiling face.

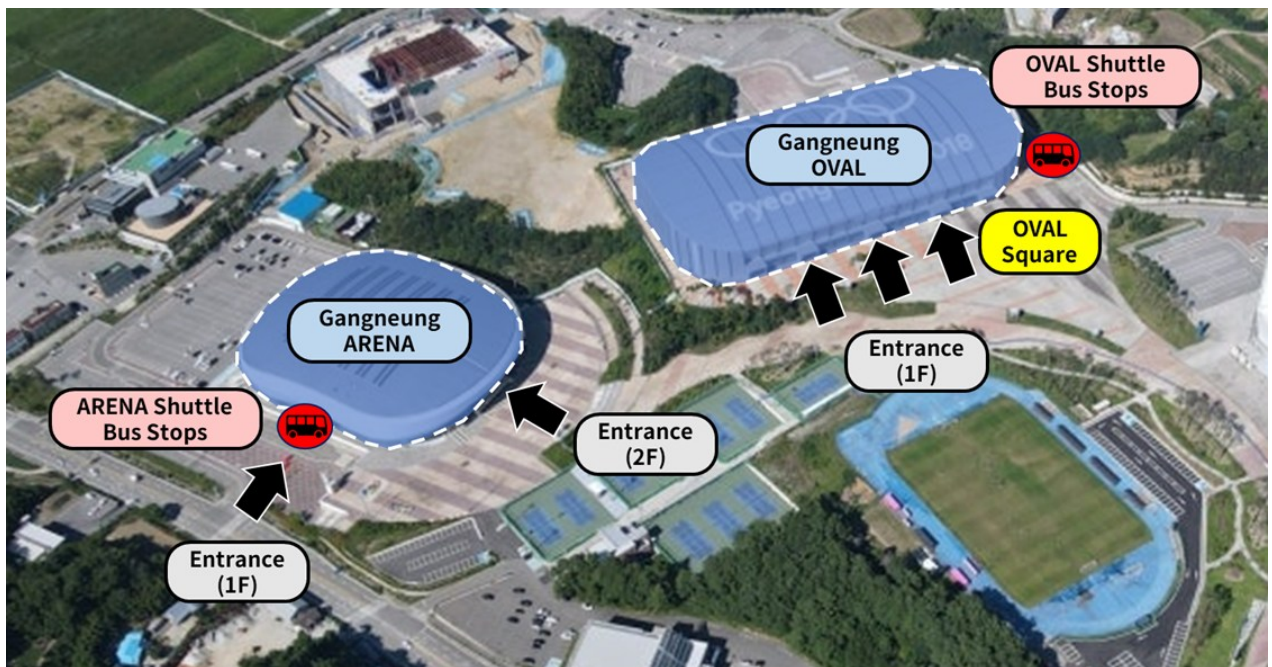


## 1.5. Venue Information

The main venue, Oval, is one of Korea's largest indoor facilities with a pillar-free structure and a 400m double-track rink. During the Championships, it will be transformed into a dedicated table tennis venue exclusively for the ITTF WORLD MASTERS CHAMPIONSHIPS GANGNEUNG 2026 Presented by XIOM. The Arena, which will be used as the practice venue, was originally built for the PyeongChang 2018 Winter Olympic Games and is currently one of the largest indoor sports arenas in Gangwon Province. During the Championships, it will operate as a dedicated practice hall for players.

### 1.5.1. Venue Entrance and Inter-Venue Shuttle Bus Stop

Access to the venues is restricted to designated entrances only. The inter-venue shuttle services connecting the Oval and the Arena will be provided.



### 1.5.2. Free Wi-Fi Services

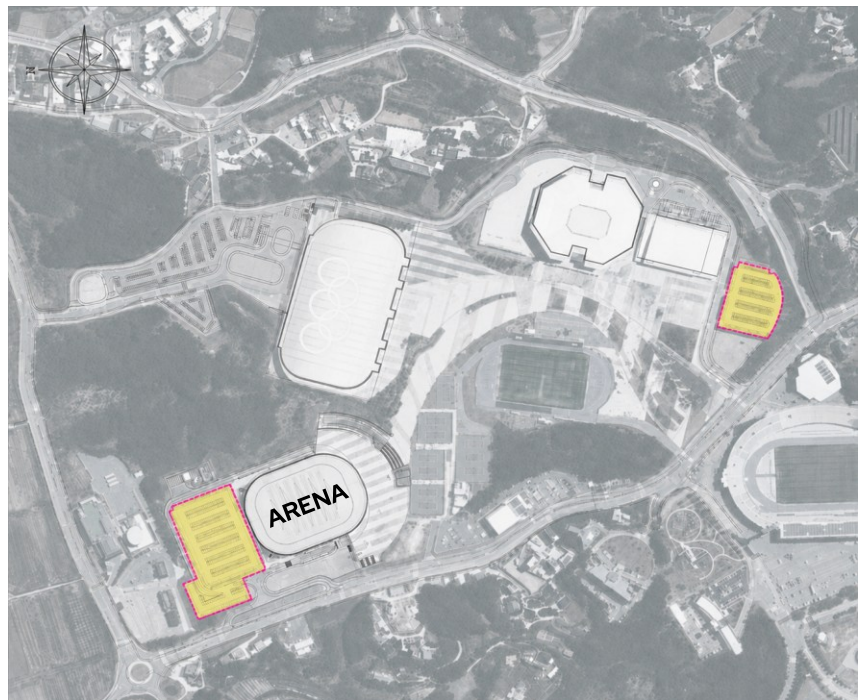

One of Gangneung's most popular beaches, featuring wide sandy shores and beautiful views of the East Sea. The bus stop next to Jumunjin Beach became especially popular after appearing in a BTS album cover, attracting many visitors.

A historic government office site where the central government officials stayed when visiting Gangneung during the Goryeo and Joseon Dynasties, offering visitors a glimpse of traditional Korean architecture and historical atmosphere. The main gate of the guesthouse is one of the few remaining buildings from the Goryeo Dynasty.



### Ojukheon

24, Yulgok-ro 3139beon-gil, Gangneung-si, Gangwon-do

Ojukheon is the birthplace of Shin Saimdang and Yulgok Yi I, and is one of Gangneung's cultural heritage sites that preserves the architectural style of the early Joseon Dynasty. The house was named "Ojukheon" after the black bamboo ("ojuk") growing around the property, and the grounds also include Mongnyongsil, Munseongsa Shrine, and the Yulgok Memorial Hall.

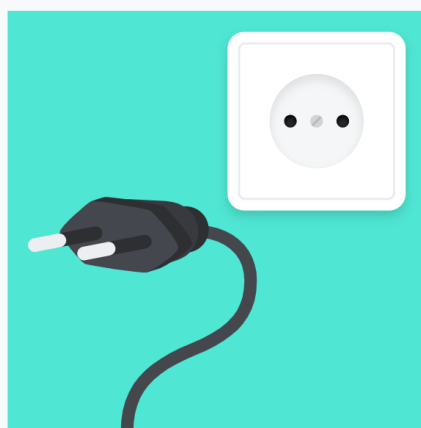
Early June in Gangneung typically features mild weather, with average temperatures ranging from 15°C to 28°C. **Due to temperature differences between day and night, bringing a light jacket is recommended.** Occasional rainfall may occur, so carrying an umbrella or raincoat is recommended.

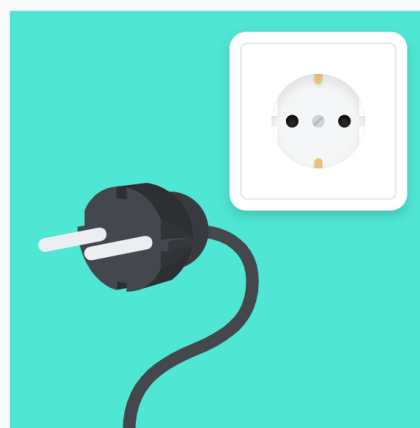

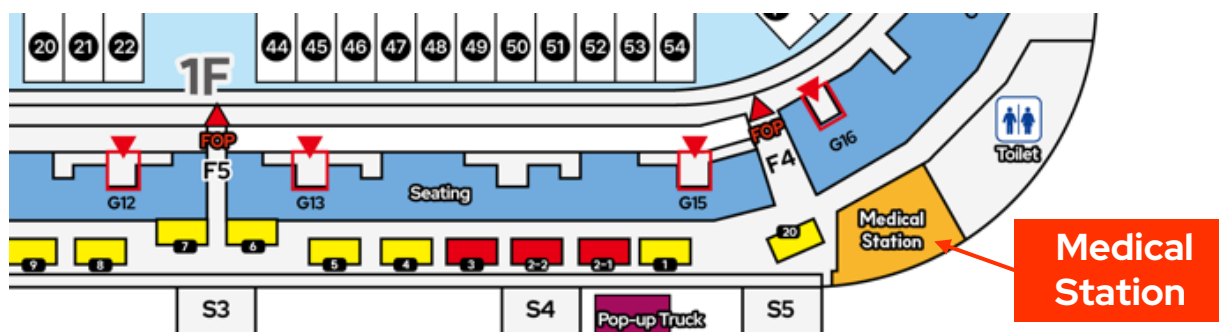
## 9.1. Venue Medical Services

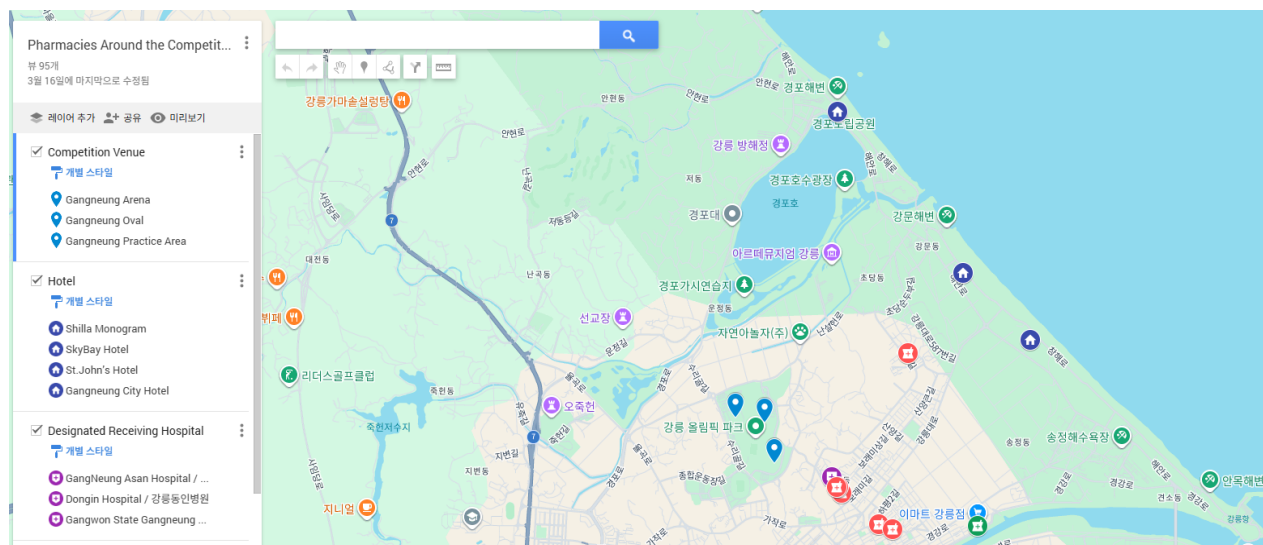

## 9.2. Designated Hospitals & Pharmacies

In the event of an accident or medical emergency at the venue during the Championships, three designated hospitals in the Gangneung area have been assigned for emergency transportation by ambulance for players and participants. # 5 Key Tips for

## Preventing Respiratory Infectious Diseases



### 1. Practice Good Cough Etiquette

- Wear a mask if you have respiratory symptoms.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve when you cough or sneeze.
- Wash your hands with soap after coughing or sneezing.
- Dispose of used tissues or masks in a trash bin immediately.



### 2. Wash Your Hands Regularly

- Wash with soap and running water for at least 30 seconds.
- Do this before and after going out, before and after eating, after blowing your nose, after coughing or sneezing, and after using the restroom, etc.

\* One out of five respiratory infections can be prevented by washing hands with soap.



### 3. Do not Touch Your Eyes, Nose, or Mouth with Unwashed Hands



### 4. Ventilate Indoor Spaces Often

- Every 2 hours, ventilate for 10 minutes
- In public spaces like schools and daycare centers, open doors and windows at the same time for better airflow.
